Dear Friends,

We look forward to sharing the High Holidays together. The PJC has been busy preparing for another year of meaningful services, and a full program of related activities. In this packet, you will find a complete schedule and informational flyers for all services and activities from *Selichot* through *Sukkot*. A few logistical reminders:

- ✧ Rosh Hashanah begins on Sunday evening, September 29<sup>th</sup>;
- ✧ Childcare starts at 9:00 a.m. each day. Our children's programs will begin at 10:00 a.m., followed by lunch and supervised activities through the end of the adults services; and
- ✧ The PJC will be full, and we do not have "tickets" for assigned seating. For us to be able to ensure adequate seating, it is important that everyone bringing guests complete the Guest Registration. If you are coming with a large family and expect to find seats all together, please plan to arrive early.

Again this year, we offer a wide range of programs, and encourage you to consider adding a new tradition to your family's observance. Come to Tashlich at Shore Park on the afternoon of Rosh Hashanah Day 1. Cast your sins into the water, and stay for dessert and frisbee. Or, make this the first year that you put up a Sukkah at home. It will be a great experience, and the PJC has a Sukkah rental program that makes it easy.
