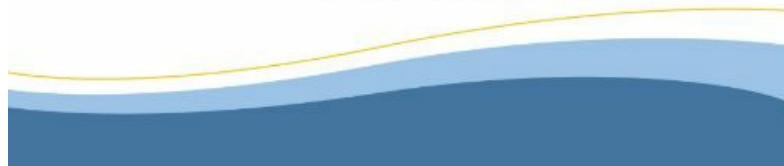

Israel Story

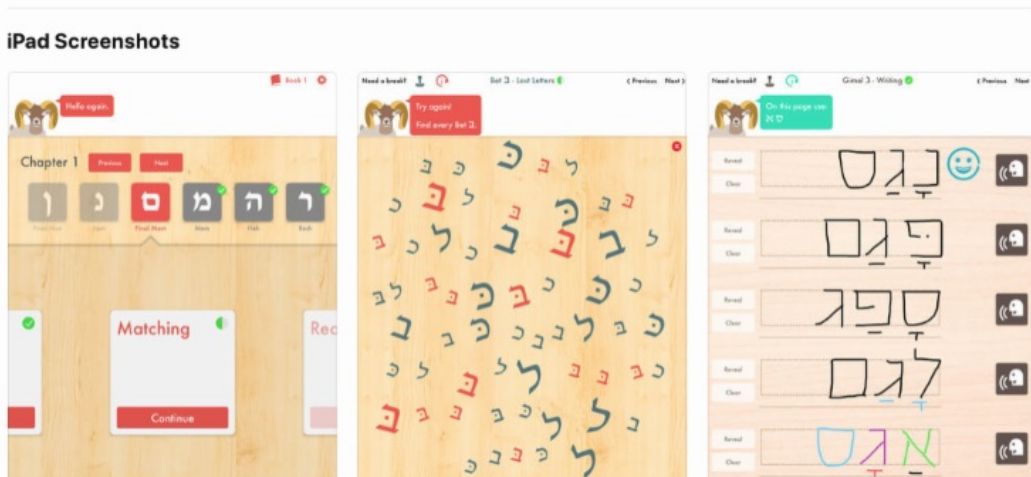
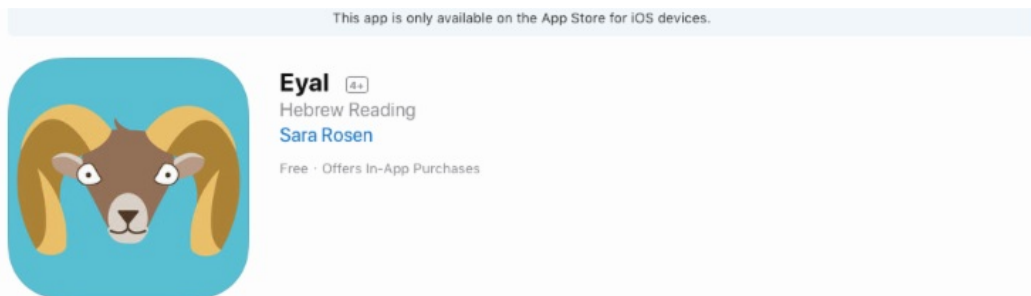
is created in the style of NPR's, "This American Life." It tells compelling stories about Israeli life, and is very entertaining. Podcasts are available in both English and Hebrew.
