**April 20th-23rd**

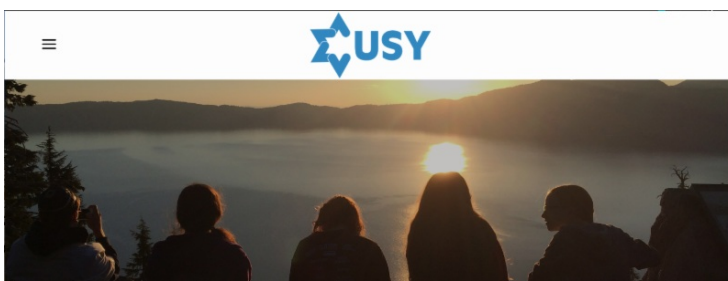
